Pensioner Discount:

To be eligible for a 50% concession, pensioners must produce one of the following:

1. Pensioner Concession Card
2. Veteran Affairs Card
3. Commonwealth Seniors Health Card together with a Seniors Card
4. State Concession Card.

Sterilisation Discount:

To be eligible for the sterilised rate you must produce one of the following:

1. Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate
2. Signed Statutory Declaration (obtainable from the City)
3. Authorised Officer sighting ear tattoo.

Previous Registration Certificates are not acceptable as proof of sterilisation.

Microchipping:

All dogs aged 3 months and over must be microchipped and details must be provided at time of registration.

A dog is exempt from microchipping if a certificate is given by a veterinarian stating that the implantation of a microchip in the dog may adversely affect the health and welfare of the dog.

RESTRICTED BREEDS

These breeds are prescribed as restricted breeds for the definition of dangerous dog (restricted breed) in section 3(1)– dogo Argentino;

- (a) fila Brasileiro;
- (b) Japanese tosa;
- (c) American pit bull terrier;
- (d) pit bull terrier;
- (e) perro de presa Canario or presa Canario;
- (f) any other breed of dog the importation of which is prohibited absolutely by the Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations 1956 (Commonwealth).
